### DATTCO COVID-19 Protective Measures

DATTCO takes the health and safety of all passengers and employees seriously. The following protective measures have been put in place to ensure safe and healthy travel.

### Vehicle Sterilization

- Vehicle maintenance personnel will thoroughly wipe all interior high traffic surfaces during routine maintenance servicing before the vehicle is placed back into operation, including bathroom facilities.
- "High-traffic" surfaces will be wiped down regularly with an EPA registered disinfectant and disposable towels. These areas include buttons, handholds, rails, stanchions, driver compartment areas, and seat top surfaces, areas most prone to repeated hand contact by passengers
- Buses are provided with a receptacle for all materials used to sanitize the vehicle as well as properly dispose of used personal protective equipment, such as gloves, face shields or masks.
- All drivers are equipped with hand sanitizer, and EPA Registered Disinfectant spray, and towels in order to perform continues sterilization.
- Cabin air filters and ventilation systems have been checked and serviced prior to charter

## Screening Employees for Coronavirus per CDC Standards

All DATTCO employees are must adhere to the following guidelines per the CDC recommendations (see attached document).

- 1) Employee does not experience body temperature reading higher than 100.4°F/38°C or higher
- 2) Employees has not experienced any symptoms of coronavirus, including fever, cough, headache, runny nose, etc.
- 3) Employee has had no known contact with anyone who has experienced symptoms or tested positive for coronavirus
- 4) All drivers are aware of pertinent CDC COVID-19 prevention recommendations.

All drivers are equipped with personal protective equipment including mask, face shields, and gloves as well as hand sanitizer, EPA Registered Disinfectant, and towel in order to continue to protect themselves and passengers.

#### **Passenger Boarding Procedures**

Drivers have been instructed to adhere to the following procedures during the boarding process

- 1) Upon arrival, passengers will drop of luggage next to the bus while keeping social distance from drivers. Drivers will handle all luggage and place them in the luggage storage compartment while being equipped with nitrile gloves. Drivers have been instructed not to touch their face while handling luggage. Once loading of luggage is complete, gloves will be removed, disposed of properly, and the driver must immediately wash their hands with soap and water or properly disinfect with sanitizer.
- 2) Drivers must remain outside the bus at all times while passengers are boarding, keeping appropriate social distance and may not enter the bus until all passengers have boarded.
- 3) Buses will be filled to 50% capacity to ensure passenger have the ability to follow social distancing standards.

- 4) Passengers are asked to refrain from using the first few rows of seats in order to establish a 6-foot social distance perimeter around the driver.
- 5) Once all passengers have boarded the bus the driver will then board the bus.

#### **Additional Precautions**

- Military passengers will be allowed to perform addition sanitizing if the prefer
- Hand sanitizing stations are made available in the boarding area as well the bathrooms.
